Hello! My name is Jack Hobe. I live in the Philadelphia area and teach educational, interactive workshops that introduce audiences of all ages to nature drawing, nature journaling, scientific inquiry, sketching techniques, and nature appreciation. This flyer is designed to help you plan an event for your organization or group by providing information about my programs. I have experience teaching programs for numerous nature-oriented organizations in the Delaware Valley area, and look forward to hosting a workshop with you. Thank you for your interest!

General Program Details:

- My programs are ideal for nature centers, nature reserves, wildlife refuges, preserves, National Parks, zoos, arboretums, aquariums, natural history museums, nature centers, homeschool groups, and churches.
- **Suggested number of participants: 10-20.**
- Location: I am available to travel to your organization in the Delaware Valley area (note that travel expenses will be included in the final fee) or do a remote presentation through Zoom. Note that many of my programs are interactive and are designed to be presented in either an indoor classroom or outdoor setting suitable for the presentation.
- I have several standard 1.5 - 2 hour programs (**How to Draw Birds, Introduction to Nature Journaling**) that can be presented to your attendees without the need for customization. I am also happy to create a custom workshop topic suited to your mission or conservation focus (e.g. How to Draw Plants/Flowers, How to Draw Mammals, Field Sketching Techniques, Drawing Raptors in Flight, Drawing Waterfowl, Introduction to Birding Techniques, and many more).
- Program duration is variable depending on your needs, but **my standard programs run minimum 1.5 hours**. Most of my workshops consist of a 30-40 min. informational lecture followed by an outdoor sketching session (45-60 min.).
- I will provide a list of materials that attendees are required to have for the program. Alternatively, the hosting organization may wish to provide these materials. I will also provide a short blurb for the program, instructor bio and images pertaining to the workshop topic for you to use in marketing.

Payment Information:

Suggested minimum instructor fee is \$250 for a 1.5-hour workshop, but is negotiable depending on the organization's budget and desired workshop length. Payment is due upon completion of the workshop.
